Name	Definition
Ferrous	Metals that contain Iron. Examples are Mild steel Wrought Iron etc Ferum is the latin for Iron. Ferrous means 'with Iron'.
Centre Lathe	The Centre Lathe is used to manufacture cylindrical shapes from a range of materials including; steels and plastics
Galvanised	Where Iron or Steel is covered with a coat of Zinc to stop it rusting
Aluminium	The chemical element of atomic number 13, a light silvery-grey metal
Equipment	The necessary items for a particular purpose, this can include clothing. tools and machinery
Knurling	Knurling is a manufacturing process, typically conducted on a lathe, whereby a pattern of straight, angled or crossed lines is rolled into the material
Manufacturing	Manufacturing is the processing of raw materials or parts into finished goods through the use of tools, human labour, machinery, and chemical processing
Tailstock	A tailstock, is a device often used as part of an engineering lathe. It is used to apply support to the rotary axis of a workpiece being machined.
